



Navigator I

Make your Disney cruise even more unforgettable with the Disney Cruise Line Navigator app! Use it at home to plan your trip, book premium activities, make special requests and check in online. Once on board, use it to view your cruise schedule and reserve activities, communicate with family and friends with the handy chat feature, view restaurant menus, get important information about ship locations and ports of call, receive digital receipts and much more.





Inline Check-In

Online check-in can be a bit of a challenge, but with a little preparation, you can have a smooth online check-in experience. Here's what you need to know.

Check-In dates vary by your Castaway Cay level or sailing Concierge:

- Pearl / Concierge Level = 40 days prior to sailing
- Platinum Level = 38 days prior to sailing
- Gold Level = 35 days prior to sailing
- Silver Level = 33 days prior to sailing
- 1st time Disney Cruise Line cruisers = 30 days prior to sailing

Before Your Online Check-In Date

- Confirm that your government-issued IDs are in date and match your reservation (spelling of name, date of birth ect).
- Create a Disney Cruise Line account and link your reservation(s).
- Download the Disney Cruise Line Navigator app and check for updates.
- Link your friends and family's reservations to yours so you can be seated together at dinner and book activities together.
- Book your on-board activities and shore excursions.
- Double-check your online check-in date and time.
- Remember that online check-in closes at midnight the day before your cruise.

Have Ready at Check-In

- A clear photo of each passenger's passport, with no glare and the passport number, name, issue and expiration date clearly visible.
- Passports that are valid for at least 6 months after your debarkation date and have at least a few blank pages available.
- A clear photo of each passenger, taken from the shoulders up and with a plain background.
- Flight information, even if you are not using Disney transportation.
- Pre- and Post-Cruise hotel information.
- A credit card to keep on file for onboard purchases.
- The name and phone number of an emergency contact who is not traveling with you.

I recommend having copies of your passports and photos on both your computer and phone in case the website or app is not working for you.

Online Check-In

On Your Online Check-In Date

- 1. Select your sailing and click "Begin Check-In."
- 2. Click through each step in order. The icons on the right will fill in as each section is completed.
- 3. Provide your guest information.
- 4. Set up your onboard account.
- 5. Enter your travel plans.
- 6. Select your port arrival time. Most people will select the earliest time available so there is more time to explore the ship before you sail away. You will also be automatically assigned a Boarding Group. *Note: If you are staying at a Walt Disney World resort hotel and have booked the Disney Cruise Line transfer, you will not be asked to select a Port Arrival Time.*
- 7. Review and agree to the cruise contract.
- 8. Once you have completed your online check-in, you will see the message "You're All Set to Sail!" You can check back periodically before your cruise to ensure your documents have been reviewed by a cast member and your check-in has been upgraded from "Pending" to "Complete."
- **9**. Be sure to print out your Port Arrival Form, and if you like add it to the digital wallet on your phone.

30 Days Out

You can book the Princess Gathering, a meet-and-greet with Disney princesses that is included in your cruise fare, 30 days before your cruise. However, reservations are required and space is limited due to its popularity. You can also purchase a photo package in advance for the best price. The price will be higher if you purchase it on board. Disney Visa holders get a discount on board, but the prepurchase price is the best price for all guests. Make sure to add any special requests, such as high chairs, bedrails and cribs, dietary requests, or celebration planning, at least 5 weeks before your sail date. You can easily do this through the app.

re-Cruise Checklist

Prepare for your upcoming cruise by following this pre-cruise checklist. Based on your arrival at your cruise embarking port location one day prior to setting sail.

Now that your cruise is booked, I recommend you:

- Download the <u>Disney Cruise Line Navigator app</u>, this includes all members of your party to will be taking a mobile phone on the cruise.
- Take the time to reserve premium activities to ensure you do not miss out. Consider Port Adventures, adult-exclusive dining, spa treatments, registering for kids clubs, Bibbidi Bobbidi boutique, photography packages (the photography packages may be discounted prior to sailing) and more through the Disney Cruise Line Navigator app or online via <u>My Reservations</u>.

15 Days before setting sail

- Begin organizing your luggage and purchasing any items you may wish to take with you.
- Review any items you would like to submit a special request for, for example, dietary requirements, baby-related items, or mobility equipment.
- Complete <u>Online Check-In</u> to save time on Embarkation Day. Be sure to select a Port Arrival time.
- Check the <u>Know Before You Go</u> page to check for any updates or changes to the Health & Safety information, particularly around COVID-19.

Pre-Cruise Checklist

1 to 2 Days before setting sail

- Double check you have packed all items you wish to take and attach the Disney Cruise Line luggage tags to your bags.
- Ensure your carry on day bag is ready with medication, prescription glasses, contact lens, essential documents (ID, passports & all other important documents) are together & easy to access, camera, sunscreen, hat, sunglasses, change of clothes & swimwear, snacks & water bottle.

Embarkation Day

If your cruise is eligable, wear your DisneyBand+ during your port arrival experience (available at US ports only) and enjoy hands-free convenience as you make your way on to the ship.

Please be aware that there is no advantage to going to the Port terminal any earlier then your scheduled arrival time. Guests are permitted at the Port terminal or parking area beforehand. If you arrive early, you will be asked to return later at your scheduled arrival time.

Character Calls

Great for kids and adults alike. Build excitement for your upcoming cruise by scheduling a pre-recorded Disney Character Call. Visit <u>My Reservations</u> and and select "Request Call" beside the Free Character Call to select the day, time and character.

Onboard Gifts

Make your upcoming cruise more memorable—or bid family and friends a festive "bon voyage"—with delightful gifts and amenities delivered on board the ship. Most items will be delivered to a stateroom on Embarkation Day, although some products like cakes and select beverages can be delivered to a stateroom or a dining room on a delivery date and time of your choosing.

Please note that all cake orders must be placed no later than 7 days prior to sail date. For all gifts that are not cakes, orders must be placed no later than 3 days prior to sail date.

Travelling to Port

Disney Cruise Line Bus

The Disney Cruise Line (DCL) bus provides a full Disney experience and offers convenience and a smooth transition to the ship. However, is not included in the price of your Disney Cruise. The DCL bus services guests from Walt Disney World resorts, travelers at Orlando International Airport (MCO), and guests at the Hyatt Regency. The cost from MCO to the Disney terminal is \$39 per Guest each way or \$78 roundtrip.

Remember to factor in the one-hour bus trip to Port Canaveral from Walt Disney World and 45 minutes from Orlando International Airport on your embarkation day.

Independent Shuttle Companies

An affordable option for larger parties, there are many companies with a range of sedans, SVU's, vans & limousines. Good options are Go Port Canaveral, Cocoa Beach Shuttle or Ace Luxury Transport.

Ride Share and Taxi

Taxi's and companies like Uber and Lyft offer direct transport to the port. These services are ideal for smaller groups.

A Note on Flights

Flying in? Flights to your Disney Cruise holiday are recommended the day prior to Embarkation Day. This allows for a smoother more relaxed Embarkation Day.

For Flights out, a flight on Debarkation Day is best scheduled after 12 to give you plenty of time to disembark the ship and collect your luggage.



Travel Documents

To assist you in preparing for your cruise, all passengers are required to have certain travel documents in order to board the ship.

What documents will be required when I check in for my cruise?

- At check-in, all Guests must present valid passports or other acceptable proof of citizenship.
- All travelers are required to have a valid passport to enter or re-enter the United States by air.
- In addition to a valid passport, many countries require an entry visa based on your nationality. It is each Guest's responsibility to identify and to obtain all the necessary visas before embarking on the cruise. Because requirements may vary, Guests are advised to contact their local consulate or embassy for more information on required travel documentation for all ports of call during the cruise.
- The Guest who booked the cruise must present a copy of the Online Check-In Port Arrival Form at check-in. You can save time during the boarding process by completing this document ahead of time through <u>My</u> <u>Online Check-in</u>.
- When a minor (age 17 and under) travels without a parent or legal guardian, an accompanying adult must present an Authorization For Minor To Travel Without a Parent or Legal Guardian Form, completed and signed by that child's parent or legal guardian.

A Note on Passports:

- You will need to provide your passport number at least 75 days prior to the start of your vacation in your Guest Information Form in <u>My Online Check-in</u>.
- Make sure your passports aren't expired or about to expire. Many countries require your passport to be valid up to 3 months after the completion of your cruise.



Travel Documents - Adults

What documents do I need?

In order to board the ship at the start of a cruise, all Guests (except children 15 years or younger) must provide a valid government-issued photo ID. For certain international itineraries, you will also need to present a valid passport and travel visa.

Do I need a Passport?

Not all Disney Cruise itineraries require that you travel with a passport & you may be able to use alternative documentation. A passport is not required if your cruise embarks from a United States port, travels only to certain locations (Canada, Mexico, Bahamas, or Caribbean), and returns to the same port. In these instances, for added security it is recommend that you carry a valid passport. Carrying a passport offers protection in the unlikely event that you need to fly home from a foreign port, you can board a flight without delay.

For Disney Cruises with international itineraries where your cruise embarks from or will finish in another country outside of the United States, you will need a valid passport.



Alternatives to a Passport

To be used, a document must be in date and the original version.

Acceptable document alternatives include:

- U.S. Passport Card
- Trusted Traveller Card (NEXUS, FAST)
- Enhanced Driver's License (EDL)
- Uniformed Services ID Card

Travel Documents - Minors

What documents do I need for my children?

For your children you will need to provide one of the following documents;

- Original or copy of their state-issued birth certificate AND Governmentissued photo ID
 - Puerto Rico birth certificates issued prior to 7/1/10 are not acceptable
 - Hospital-issued birth certificates are not acceptable
- Original Consular Report of Birth Abroad issued by the Department of State AND Government-issued photo ID
- Original Certificate of Naturalization issued by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services AND Government-issued photo ID

In some circumstances when cruising with your minor child/children & the child/children's other parent is absent, you may also need to bring along a signed, notarized permission letter in addition to proof of the child's citizenship. This is a recommendation of the US Customs and Border Protection.

Children 15 years or younger

Children 15 years of age and younger are required to present one of the documents listed above, but do not need to present a Government-issued photo ID

Travel without a Parent or Legal Guardian

The Authorization for Minor to Travel without a Parent or Legal Guardian form authorizes an adult (age 18 and older) other than the parent or legal guardian to retain care, custody and control of a child during the span of a Disney cruise vacation. It is required for each child traveling without a parent or legal guardian. A parent or legal guardian must complete this form, naming each of the children it applies to, and it must be presented by the authorized adult during check-in at the port terminal.

Disney Inclusions & Exclusions

What is Included?

Your cruise price includes almost every part of your onboard experience, such as:

- Your stateroom along with all applicable taxes and port fees
- Room service 24 hours a day, for breakfast, lunch, dinner & snacks
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner
- Soft drinks served at meals and at each ship's beverage station
- Snacks and ice cream throughout the ship
- Disney Character Meet & Greets
- Kids Clubs (3 17yrs)
- Gym facilities Pools, waterslides, hot tubs
- Sporting activities such as mini golf & basketball
- Castaway Cay beaches & restaurants (if relevant)
- Entertainment including live Broadway-style productions at the Walt Disney Theatre as well as Disney movie classics and current first-run films at the Buena Vista Theatre



What is Not Included?

While you're sailing, there are a few optional services and activities that do require an additional charge, including Port Adventures excursions, spa and salon services, Bibbidi Bobbidi Boutique, babysitting in the ship's nurseries (6mths to 3yrs), onboard photography service, phone calls, video games, bingo, alcoholic beverages, and our adults-only dining venues, Palo (aboard all ships) & Remy (aboard the Disney Dream and Disney Fantasy). Tips/Gratuities & Travel Insurance are also excluded.

Dietary requests and/or food allergies

Disney Cruise Line offers gluten-free, vegetarian, no-sugar-added, dairy-free and lighter-note offerings on our table-service restaurant menus. Dietary special requests are available with no additional charge through the <u>Special Requests</u> <u>application</u> under <u>My Reservations</u>. Guests may submit their requests up to 3 days prior to embarkation.

Dietary requests notated on your reservation will not be automatically applied at our quick-service meal locations or through in-room dining.

Once on board the ship, please be sure to:

- Visit the Onboard Dining Session offered on embarkation day.
- Notify the dining team while ordering at any of our dining venues, even if you previously indicated it during the reservation process.

Worried About Getting Sea/Motion Sick?

There are many motion sickness remedies available from patches to pills or wristbands. If you think motion sickness may be an issue, seek health advice on what may be most effective for you. Other general rules are to avoid port holes and over indulging in alcohol & and sugary treats.

Fresh air, distractions with fun activities, drinking plenty of water, and eating small meals regularly can help. If you are not up to dining, room service is a good alternative where you can request items like chicken soup, plain crackers, peppermint, or lemon ginger tea.

You can visit the onboard <u>Health Cent</u>re for assistance. The staff are all very welcoming and know all the tricks to help you feel better.

Pregnancy & Infants

Pregnancy & Cruise Restrictions

Cruising is a great holiday option for all stages of life, if your doctor has advised cruising is safe for both mum & baby and before 24 weeks along in the pregnancy. Due to limitations of medical care, both on board and in various ports of call, women who have entered or exceeded their 24th week of pregnancy, at any time during the cruise are advised against cruising.

Cruising with infants & young children

Families traveling with babies and young children have access to a host of onboard services and amenities with Disney Cruise Line. The minimum age to sail aboard a Disney Cruise Line ship is 6 months on the day of sailing.

Complimentary diaper disposal units, bottle warmers, bottle sterilizers, cribs and playpens are available upon request from the stateroom host. Electrical appliances including baby monitors, humidifier, white noise/sleep machines are allowed on board, however do need to be inspected for safety prior to use.

For your convenience, there are <u>shops</u> aboard all Disney Cruise ships offering diapers and other common baby supplies including:

- Disposable diapers
- Infant formula
- Pull-up style diapers
 Baby food
 - Pacifiers

- Diaper rash cream
- Bottles
 - Baby shampoo
- Training pants
 Baby lotion

Swim diapers

- Baby powder

Fresh pureed vegetables can be prepared at the main dining rooms and through room service upon request. Guests may bring baby food and formula onboard the ship as carry-on items as long as they are pre-packaged, unopened and do not require any food preparation from the kitchen.

It is encouraged you to bring your own stroller, as the ship has a very limited number of strollers available on a first-come basis. For ease of carrying and maneuvering on board, it is recommended you bring a lightweight, foldable stroller.

All services and amenities are offered on a first-come, first-served basis. You can request a convertible crib or other special requests by signing into My Reservations, selecting "Special Requests" and filling out our Special Request form.

Prohibited Items

What is Prohibited?

In order to maintain a safe and secure environment for all Guests and Crew, Disney Cruise Line has a zero weapons policy and prohibits these items on board the ships and ashore at Castaway Cay. Examples include: Illegal narcotics/drugs, firearms, pellet/paintball pistols, sling shot, diving equipment, explosives, Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacons (EPIRB), highly flammable liquids and combustible substances, knives, lasers, stun gun, restraining devices and offensive weapons, hand and leg cuffs, pepper spray and taser.

Additionally, the following items are restricted for safety reasons and should not be brought on board: aquatic items ie. pool noodles, balloons, kites, candles, electrical appliances ie blender, coffee machine, metal detectors, musical instruments, pets, power tools, remote controlled devices ie. drones, sporting equipment, wheeled recreational equipment ie. skateboard.

Exceptions to the Prohibited items

Electrical Appliances include curling irons, flat irons, hair dryers (all ships offer a hand-held hair dryer in each stateroom), shavers.

Toy Exceptions include store-bought Light sabers, plastic toy 'pirate' swords, plastic store-bought toy "Mjolnir" hammers (Thor's hammer).

Sporting Equipment including Golf Clubs may be brought onboard & stored in a Guest's stateroom, baseballs, basketballs, footballs, soccer balls and volley balls may be brought onboard, stored in Guest's staterooms and used off the ship in ports of call.

What to expect on

Embarkation Day

Check In Online

Save time by checking in via the Navigator App, hold onto your day bag & have all travel documents on hand.

Time to Explore

Once aboard get to know your home away from home with a self-guided walk around the ship using the map on the Navigator App. Alternatively, join the staff-guided Walking Ship Tour.

Connection

On board switch your mobile phone to airplane mode straight away to avoid roaming charges. Connect to the ship's WIFI and open the Navigator App. Please be aware that using the WIFI for any activity other than the Navigator app, such as email and surfing the Internet, is subject to additional charges.

Activities

All open activities are listed in the Navigator app or a printed copy is available at Guest Services. To enjoy activities as soon as you board such as swimming & the water slide, be sure to pack suitable clothing such as swimwear, sunscreen and a change of clothes.

Other activities to sign up for on embarkation day are beverage tastings, spa services, <u>Oceaneer Club/Lab</u>, specialty dining (<u>Palo or Remy</u>), Port adventures, I<u>t's a Small World Nursery</u>, and special c<u>haracter Meet & Greets</u>.

Safety Drill

All Guests must participate in the pre-departure assembly drill to comply with U.S. Coast Guard and international safety regulations. Everyone on board will be notified when the drill is to begin and everyone is required to take part. You will be asked to follow the instructions heard over the ship's loudspeakers. Once the drill is completed, it's time to set sail! Tips for a smooth

Embarkation Day

Plan to Arrive Early

You can typically choose your arrival time when you check in for your cruise. It is a good idea to arrive at least one hour early to allow for parking, unloading, luggage drop-off, check-in, and security screening.

Bags

Ensure your day bag has everything you may need in case your luggage doesn't arrive until late afternoon. Great items to pack in your day bag are:

- lanyards- to hold your Key to the World cards
- sunscreen
- sunglasses
- swimwear & plastic bag if you plan on swimming
- prescription medications
- seasickness remedies
- chargers for electronic devices
- identification (passports/birth certificates)
- Port Arrival Form (that you printed after online check-in)
- dollar bills for tipping
- pen

If you are traveling with children, a snack is essential to starve off hunger while you wait to board, a child's diaper bag with baby essentials that are enough to last the day.

On the Ship

Time to explore and familiarise yourself with the ship layout, check out facilities like the gym, spa & kids clubs and look for the rotational dining restaurants.

Lunch is included on the first day, and there are a variety of great options to choose from, including buffets, a poolside eatery, a sit-down restaurant, or even ice cream.



Away Party Sail

Arguably one of the highlights of a Disney Cruise is the Sail Away Deck Party. Get ready to dance with Captain Mickey & Minnie Mouse and their pals Donald, Daisy, Goofy, Pluto and cruise staff.

Get ready for all sorts of excitement at the happiest celebration at sea! The deck party builds anticipation as images of the fun to come are featured on the Funnel Vision—you might even see yourself on the big screen!

Then the countdown on the big screen begins. It's a magical introduction to your vacation as confetti and streamers rocket through the air, shooting skyward while a Disney classic bellows from the ship's blow horn. And as the party comes to an end, you know the fun is just beginning. So, be sure to check your Disney Cruise Line Navigator app to explore all the excitement that awaits you on your cruise vacation.

Get to know your

ey to the World

When you check in on Embarkation Day, each member of your party will receive a Key to the World card. This card is your room key, cruise ID, and charge card for all onboard purchases.

It also includes your dining rotation, Castaway Club membership details, cruise dates, Disney Cruise Ship name, adult/minor status, and muster drill location.

You will still be issued a Key to the World Card even if you get a DisneyBand+ Be sure to keep your Key to the World card with you at all times! The Disney Cruise restaurant names are shortened on the card to the first letter of the restaurant name, for example:

Disney Fantasy: E – Enchanted Garden R – Royal Court A – Animator's Palette

Disney Band+

DisneyBand+ is a waterproof wristband that makes your Disney cruise experience more magical. The bands are optional and are not part of your Disney Cruise fare, they can be used in place of your Key to the World Card. Available on select sailings aboard the Disney Wish and Disney Fantasy. You can use it to board the ship, access your stateroom, charge food and merchandise to your stateroom folio, and more. It is convenient, fun, and adds even more magic to your cruise!

Purchase a DisneyBand+

There are a range of designs and colors that cater to all members of the family, the cost is solid bands are \$34.99, and themed designs cost \$44.99, plus tax.

What is Rotational Dining?

Rotational dining is the Disney Cruise Line way of making sure that all Guests get to enjoy each of the 3 themed dining venues while on board.

You will receive your restaurant schedule and table number upon arrival by checking your Disney Cruise Line <u>Navigator App</u>. Then, each evening, you, your tablemates and servers will rotate to a different restaurant. As you rotate, the same wait staff—who know your preferences—will serve you each night while you get to experience the unique atmosphere of each dining venue.

Children's menus are available in all the restaurants in your rotation. For small children, you can request a high chair or booster seat via the <u>Navigator App</u>. Discover all the restaurants and <u>dining options</u> aboard Disney Cruise Line by clicking <u>here</u>.

When is dinner served?

Each night, there are 2 seating times for dinner. These times vary based on itinerary. In general, for sailings out of the domestic US, the Main Seating begins at 5:45 PM, and the Second Seating begins at 8:00 PM. For sailings out of Europe, the Main Seating begins at 6:00 PM, and the Second Seating begins at 8:30 PM.

For your assigned seating time and restaurant rotation, please check your Disney Cruise Line <u>Navigator App</u> upon arrival.

If your seating preference is not available, you can request an alternate seating time by joining the Waitlist. Requests are subject to availability and can be made through M<u>y</u> <u>Reservations</u>.



Breakfast & Lunch

All Disney Cruise Line ships have a buffet-style restaurant, called Cabanas (on the Magic, Wonder, Dream, and Fantasy) or Marceline Market (on the Wish and the upcoming Treasure) serving breakfast and lunch. 

Debarkation Day

As all good things come to an end, so does your magical holiday aboard the Disney Cruise Line. Debarkation Day may mark your final hours of your holiday however the process starts the afternoon or evening before. Most Guests are prompted by the luggage tags & ships daily newsletter, alternatively you can also find information in the Navigator App.

Settling your Onboard Account

A copy of your account will be delivered to your stateroom & if a credit card is nominated the amount will be automatically deducted. If you notice a discrepancy to the charges on your account, head down to the reception desk to discuss the charges.

Gratuity Envelopes

On the eve of Debarkation Day you will have 4 envelopes delivered to your stateroom. Each envelope is for the staff who have been with you for your cruise and include Server, Assistant Server, Head Server, and Stateroom Host. These envelopes are used for additional tips you may wish to give to the staff and are optional.

Disembark the Ship

When making plans to disembark, the most important factor is your travel plans on Debarkation Day. If you have a flight booked prior to 11:30AM (considered an early flight) you will need to request priority to ensure you are one of the first groups to leave the ship.

Luggage

The provided luggage tags will help you to locate your luggage once off the ship. The night prior to Debarkation Day you can leave your luggage to be collected & delivered to the cruise ship terminal the following morning or you may opt to keep all your luggage and bags with you. If you nominate to keep your luggage, you will be responsible to carry your bags from the ship.

Ship Terms

Aft – indicates the back of the ship. Staterooms in the Aft are located towards the back of the ship and Guests will use the Aft elevators to get to their rooms.

Bow – indicates the front of the ship and where a Disney character is located. The Disney characters by ship are: Disney Magic – Sorcerer Mickey, Disney Wonder – Steamboat Willie, Disney Dream – Captain Mickey, Disney Fantasy – Sorcerer Mickey & Disney Wish – Captain Minnie.

Stern – indicates the rear of the ship. This is where the name of the Disney ship and a 3D Disney character are displayed. The Disney character by ship are: Disney Magic – Botswain Goofy, Disney Wonder – Donald Duck, Disney Dream – Sorcerer Mickey, Disney Fantasy – Dumbo & Disney Wish – Rapunzel.

Port Side – when facing towards the bow (front) onboard a cruise ship, this is the side that is on the left.

Starboard Side – when facing towards the bow (front) onboard a cruise ship, this is the side that is on the right.

Forward – indicates the front of the ship. Staterooms in the Front are located in the front of the ship and Guests will use the Forward elevators to get to their rooms.

Midship – indicates the middle of the ship. Staterooms in the Midship are located in the middle of the ship and Guests will use the Midship elevators to get to their rooms.

Atrium – the entrance or lobby on the cruise ship. This space on a Disney Cruise ship is magical, sets the tone for the ship & features a large statue of a Disney character. The Disney statue by ship are: Disney Magic – Helmsman Mickey, Disney Wonder – Ariel, Disney Dream – Admiral Donald, Disney Fantasy – Mademoiselle Minnie & Disney Wish – Cinderella.

Dining Terms

Assistant Server – a crew member who will take your order & serve your drinks during each dinner service.

Server – a crew member who will take your order & serve your dinner during each dinner service. They also have a fantastic knowledge of the menu & can help with recommendations. If you have any food allergies or sensitivities let your server know on your first day.

Head Server – a crew member who manages the dining room, anything that exceeded or did not meet your expectations, this is the person to speak to.

Rotational Dining – Rotational dining is the Disney Cruise Line way of making sure that all Guests get to enjoy each of the 3 themed dining venues while on board. You will receive your restaurant schedule and table number upon arrival by checking your Disney Cruise Line Navigator App. Then, each evening, you, your tablemates and servers will rotate to a different restaurant. As you rotate, the same wait staff (who know your preferences) will serve you each night while you get to experience the unique atmosphere of each dining venue.

Main Seating – Each night, there are 2 seating times for dinner in the Rotational Dining Restaurants. These times vary based on itinerary. In general, for sailings out of the domestic US, the Main Seating begins at 5:45 PM. Can also be referred to as First Seating. You will choose your dinner seating when booking your Disney Cruise.

Second Seating – The later dinner time, begins at 8:00 PM and is less crowed and more quiet.
